How to book:

- Head booking themselves onto the conference
 - o Log into your account here and then visit the annual conference 2023 event page;
 - Click the green 'book now';
 - Tick the box that says you will be attending and follow the on-screen prompts.
- PA (or other member of staff) booking the Head onto the conference
 - o Log into your account here and then visit the annual conference 2023 event page;
 - Click the green 'book now';
 - Click the add delegate button and then existing contact;
 - Select the Head from the list of staff at your school and follow the on-screen prompts;
 - If you cannot select the IAPS Member Head ticket option then please contact the courses and conferences team on courses@iaps.uk who will be able to assist you.
- If you have a new Head starting in September or they are not yet in membership
 - Please contact the courses and conferences team on <u>courses@iaps.uk</u> who will be able to assist you in making the booking.
 - You will not be able to make the booking on the correct ticket.

Ticket options:

- IAPS Member Head
 - Only Heads at IAPS schools who carry the membership are eligible for this ticket.
 - If you have submitted an application for approval at the Summer term membership committee meeting please do not book through the website until you receive your welcome pack (which will be sent to the school you are starting the Headship at).
 - o If you are a current member who is moving school in September, please
- Full partner
 - o This is for your spouse/partner who wants to attend the whole conference.
 - This ticket includes attendance at the conference, seminar sessions, refreshments (including lunch) during the conference, and the annual conference dinner on Tuesday evening.
- Social guest
 - This is for your spouse/partner and includes attendance at the annual dinner only.



Booking accommodation:

- Accommodation is NOT included in the cost of the ticket and you will need to arrange your hotel separately.
- IAPS is working with Easy Tiger Events and they have arranged a preferential rate at six Liverpool hotels.
