Rules

- Squads must be made up of no more than 10 players, matches are 7 a side.
- Substitutes are allowed at any time as a roll on roll off.
- Schools should bring bibs in case of a kit clash.
- Normal 7 a side rules
 - Heading is NOT permitted,
 - NO goal keeper drop kicks,
 - NO offside rule
- On corners, free kicks, goal kicks and kick off all defending players must be at least 3 meters back from the ball
- Games will be 16 minutes, 8 minutes one way. Each match has a 20 minute window to be played.

- The top 2 teams from each pool will qualify for the cup competition,
- 3rd and 4th place from each pool will qualify for the plate competition.
- The groups will be decided on points
 - 3 - for a win
 - 1 - for a draw
- If points are level, then goal difference will decide. If teams are still tied, then it will be the team with the most goals scored.
- If knockout matches are still tied, then it will go straight to penalties, with each team getting 3 penalties. If still a draw, sudden death penalties will commence.
