Tournament rules

- All batting teams start on 200 runs.
- A team will consist of 8 players (no more than 10 in the squad)
- Normal rules of cricket apply.
- Eight overs per innings.
- Each over shall consist of five balls.
- Two (five-ball) overs per batting pair.
- The fielding team must bowl these within 20 minutes.
- Each pair must bowl, and wicket keep together.
- All players must bowl one over in each inning.
- When a batter is out for any reason minus five runs per wicket lost during a batting pair's innings. At the fall of a wicket the batters will switch ends – no need to switch in the event of a run out.
- Fielders do not need to rotate – however there must be a minimum of two fielders on the off- side
- Extras – wide's and no balls shall count as two runs to the batting total – if any extra runs are taken by the batters further runs will be awarded.
- If a wide or no ball is bowled on the last ball of an innings, the batting team are awarded two runs and a further legal ball is bowled.
- In the event of a tie, the team losing the fewest wickets will be awarded the victory. If this is the same, the team scoring the most runs in the first over, and consecutive overs following, will be awarded the win.
- Umpires will be strict on their judgement of wide's.
- Time saver – batting pairs will bat from the same end for all eight overs.
