## **Entering the competition**

## Booking onto an event:

- All bookings are made online via the IAPS website.
- Only a member of school staff with a school email address can book onto an event.
- If the event is fully booked, please join the waiting list and we will contact you should a space become available.

## Eligibility:

- All competitors must attend an IAPS School.
- Competitors ages are taken from 1st September.
- Only competitors who are part of the Prep School are eligible to take part.
- Competitors in Year 7 and Year 8 who are part of the Senior School are not eligible to take part in U12 and U13 events.
- Pupils can only participate in one age group throughout the competition. The competition is defined as both qualifying events and the finals.
- All schools must bring first aid and additional first aid might be provided.

## **Championship format**

## Rules and regulations

- The national governing body for basketball in England is England Basketball,
- All IAPS basketball tournaments are conducted under the <u>England</u>
  <u>Basketball</u> rules and regulations. Please read the rules and regulations in full before entering the event.
- Schools can only enter one team per age group
- If there is space, we may invite schools to bring a second team
- Max 10 players per squad and teams can be made up of boys, girls or be mixed.

All matches will be refereed by neutral umpires.

#### First aid

Please bring a first aid kit bag with you. The centre staff are all trained in first aid to assist with any first aid requirements, also. In the event of an emergency, we will call 999.

## Changing facilities

There are two ground floor changing rooms (1 male, 1 female) at the middle entrance to the sports hall, available for the players to use. They also have toilet facilities in them. These are for players only and not for adults.

There will be a separate changing room for officials/ staff and adults and adult spectators will be informed of the location of toilet facilities that they can use.
