Booking onto an event

- All bookings are made online via the <u>IAPS website</u>.
- Only a member of school staff with a school email address can book onto an event.
- If your chosen location is fully booked, please join the waiting list. Should a space become available, we will contact you to offer you the space. There is no guarantee we can find schools an event to attend.

Entry eligibility

- All competitors must attend an IAPS School.
- Competitors ages is taken from 1st September.
- Competitors can only participate in one age group throughout the competition. The competition is defined as both qualifying events and the finals.
- Unless otherwise specified, schools can only enter one team per tournament/championships.
- Only competitors who are part of the Prep School are eligible to take part.
 Competitors in Year 7 and Year 8 who are part of the Senior School are not eligible to take part in U12 and U13 events.
- All schools must bring first aid.

- Year 5 (Tri Stars 1) Swim 150m, Cycle 2000m, Run 1200m

- Year 8 (Tri Stars 3) Swim 300m, Cycle 6000m, Run 2400m
- The course is all off-road on grass.

Race Packs

- o On the day, all competitors will receive a race pack at registration.
- This will include a timing chip and race numbers.

Equipment

- Competitors are required to bring the following equipment:
- A bike which meets national safety requirements.
- Bike helmet.
- Tri-Suit or swimming costume with a t-shirt and shorts to put on after the swim.
- A number belt (not mandatory but advisable).
