Booking onto an event

- All bookings are made online via the <u>IAPS website</u>.
- Only a member of school staff with a school email address can book onto an event.
- If your chosen location is fully booked, please join the waiting list. Should a space become available, we will contact you to offer you the space. There is no guarantee we can find schools an event to attend.

Entry eligibility

- All competitors must attend an IAPS School.
- Competitors ages is taken from 1st September.
- Competitors can only participate in one age group throughout the competition. The competition is defined as both qualifying events and the finals.
- Unless otherwise specified, schools can only enter one team per tournament/championships.
- Only competitors who are part of the Prep School are eligible to take part.
 Competitors in Year 7 and Year 8 who are part of the Senior School are not eligible to take part in U13 events.
- All schools must bring first aid.

Event information

The tournament is a knockout competition, culminating in a finals day in June.

Competitors

11-a-side with a maximum of 13 players per squad.

Equipment

The school drawn at home will supply two identical match balls. Ball weight 4 3/4oz and one ball is used per innings. Balls will be provided for the semi-finals and final.

Umpiring at IAPS events

The umpire must not be a parent, it must be a member of school staff.

Qualifiers

Schools must provide a competent and confident umpire, unless otherwise advised.

Finals

There will be neutral umpires supplied for the semi-final and final. Schools should be prepared to provide an umpire for the finals.
