Timings

The event will start at 10.00am and will finish by 4.00pm (approx.). If we manage to get ahead of schedule we will go with it. Some of you have long journeys home so we will endeavour to get ahead of schedule.

Event Format

- Eight-a-side pairs cricket, (a maximum of ten players in a squad).
- There will be 4 groups of 3 teams. There will be than a further 2 matches for each team to determine final placings.
- Eight (six ball) overs per innings.
- Each pair bats for two overs.
- All members of the fielding side to bowl one over per match unless a designated wicketkeeper. In which case one bowler may bowl 2 overs but they can only do this in one match (a maximum of 10 overs per day allowed as per ECB guidelines).
- All overs will be bowled from one end in each game.
- 45 mins will be allocated for each match with a 15 mins turnaround time in case of delay.
- All matches will be played using a hard ball.

Playing regulations

- Each team will consist of 8 players from a maximum squad of 10. This is a hardball event.
- Each innings will consist of 8 x 6 ball overs with a bowler able to bowl no more than 2 overs once in the day.
- Guidance lines are provided for wides.
- Wides and no-balls will count as 2 runs with no extra ball.
- Minus 5 runs for the loss of a wicket.
- The wicketkeeper must wear full and correct protection.
- The team with the higher score wins. In the event of a tie, the team taking more wickets will win. If it is still equal, then 2 points awarded to both teams.

- Teams will be awarded 3 points for a win, 2 for a tie and 1 for a loss.
- If teams are level on points after all the matches have been completed, the best placed team will be decided on firstly, runs scored, secondly, wickets taken.
- All players must be under the age of 11 on or before the 1st September 2023.

Basic info
