## S18 - PE/Sport: Equality, diversity and inclusion in school sport

In this course, the issues surrounding EDI in school sport are identified with practical strategies to build EDI into the PE curriculum and promote diversity and inclusivity within the PE curriculum. This includes covering how to create a culture of respect, understanding and acceptance where all pupils feel valued and helping delegates to ensure that schools are engaging in EDI through school sport in an impactful way.

**Practical activity for the course will be indoors, delegates will not need any specialist equipment aside from appropriate sports attire and trainers that are suitable for indoor use. Delegates who require reasonable adjustments can participate or observe as they choose.**
