## Welcome

Welcome to Ashford School, where we are proud to be hosting the U11 boys' IAPS Hockey Tournament.

## Ashford School

Sport commands an important place within our school life for all children.

Ashford Prep School offers a wide range of games to suit most tastes, and these are available from an early age as part of our formal curriculum. Physical Education and Games begin in Nursery.

From there on, the Prep School children start competing against local Prep and Primary Schools.

Our ethos is Sport for All which means every child – no matter their ability – is provided the opportunity to represent the school competitively.

Competitive fixtures offer pupils the opportunity to represent their School in matches against other local schools, and help to promote excellence for county, regional or even national honours later in their lives. Furthermore, to promote a healthy rivalry between our pupils we also host spirited internal House competitions. In addition to our expert coaches on the staff, we have visits from outside coaches and international sports players to inspire and encourage all our sports teams. Our approach to sport is to be inclusive – for some children sport may not be their most obvious talent. However, the experiences of working as a team, and winning and losing graciously, are relevant for all levels of ability and enthusiasm and can give all children the skills to enable them to participate in and enjoy sport.

## Parking

We have parking available on site. This will be located on the left as you enter the school through the main gates. Once parked head to the rear of the car park and follow the path towards the astro.

## First Aid

Schools will be required to administer their own first aid. Ashford School's Assistant Nurse will be available throughout the tournament. Please speak to a member of Ashford School staff if you require assistance.

## Catering

Refreshments for spectators will be available in specified areas throughout the day. Lunch will be provided for umpires and teachers from 12:00pm in the pavilion. Players should bring their own lunch. Please remember we are a **NUT FREE** school. There will be a water filling station in the pavilion, and we would ask that all rubbish is placed in the bins provided.

## Extra Provisions

Our pavilion will be open and have sufficient toileting facilities for both guests and pupils. We will have changing rooms available for teams on the day should they be required.

## Umpires

Ashford School will be appointing 2 neutral umpires for the matches. Please ensure you have a member of staff competent to umpire should the need arise.

## Tournament Format

- Teams have been split into 2 pools based on travel distance
- Pool A (closest distance schools) will begin at 10:00
- Pool B (furthest distance schools) will begin at 10:30
- Games will be 10 minutes one way, with a 15 minute match allocation
- The top 2 from each pool will go through to a cup competition
- 3rd and 4th placed will go through to a plate competition
- IAPS have confirmed that the top 2 from the cup competition will qualify for the next stages

## Match Rules

- 7-a-side
- Maximum of 10 players in a squad
- In2Hockey rules apply
- Scoring - 3 point for a win, 1 for a draw, 0 for a loss

## Pool stages

- The top two teams of each pool will go through to the cup competition. 3rd and 4th placed teams will go through to a plate competition
- The group order will be decided by the number of points scored by each team
- In the event of a tie on points the following will decide final placing;
  1. Goal difference
  2. Goals scored
  3. Winner of match between the tied teams (\*Head-to-head result between two teams is the result of the match played between the two tied teams)
  4. 3 penalty strokes (3 players selected from the squad)
  5. Sudden death penalty strokes (\*Sudden death is started by the team that did not start the shoot-out and players may proceed in a different order from the initial best-of three round)

## Cup and plate stages

In the event of a draw at full time, the winner will be decided by:

1. A period of "Golden Goal" extra time up to a maximum of 5 minutes
2. Barrage of 3 penalty strokes
3. Sudden death penalty strokes

At U11 competitions, penalty strokes can be taken 5m from the goal line rather than 7m
