Travel arrangements



Flights

 Flights are not included in the package and either schools should organise these themselves or Ski Solutions can organise these as part of your ABTA and ATOL protected package.

Airport transfers

- Transfers to/from the airport (Turin or Milan Malpensa) are included in the price and arranged on behalf of schools.
- Pila is approximately 1 hour 30-minute transfer from Turin airport or 2 hours 15 minutes from Milan Malpensa.
- Schools are advised to fly into Turin or to Milan Malpensa airport.
- Milan has three airports, Malpensa, Linate and Bergamo. Malpensa is the closest to the resort. Second choice airport would be Linate at around 3 hours from resort.
- Transfers will be organised when final numbers are known.

N.B. Whilst Geneva airport is around 2 hours 40 minutes away on a clear run, we don't advise using this airport unless necessary. The route crosses 2 country borders and through the Mont Blanc tunnel. All this can add bottlenecks and makes the transfers more expensive, and open to delay.









Accommodation



Accommodation is guaranteed for the children and accompanying staff in the main hotels. Hotel assignment is done on a first come, first served basis.

Our main hotel will be the Chalet Des Alpes which is ski in/out.

The other hotels used will be:

Both of these are a short walk to the instructor meeting point.

Impulse Alpine are the prime contact with the resort and through them we have access to all supporting services.

All hotels have large dining rooms, and a lounge area where children can relax and play games.







Catering

Breakfast

Continental: Bread rolls, jams, cold meats etc.

Lunch

These will be at the Chalet Des Alpes or at the Hermitage restaurant on the mountain.

There should be hot and cold choices at lunch The ski instructors will be given a daily time slot at either 12:00 or 13:00 to take your group to the correct restaurant.

Dinner

Ususally 3 courses and will consist of primi (pasta or soup), main course, then a dessert.

Allergies

Please let Impulse Alpine know of any allergies or dietary requirements prior to arrival.











Pila resort information





The resort

Pila sits in a natural, north facing bowl and has magnificent views sweeping across the Alps, from Mont Blanc to Monte Rosa and the Matterhorn.

The resort altitude is 1800m with access to 70km of pistes from 1765-2700m. Being north facing, the snow tends to be good from early December to mid April.

It is located a 20-minute gondola ride from the historical Roman town of Aosta. Known as the 'Rome of the North'.

Training and race slope

We will be using the slope at Nuova Chatelaine for the training and races.

This is ideally suited to the event and can be viewed from the large terrace at the Hermitage restaurant opposite the bottom of the race piste.

The bottom of the race piste can be accessed on foot with a walk of around 20 minutes if there are any parents who do not ski and wish to spectate.









Instructors & groups


All the Impulse Alpine instructors and the race coaching staff on the hill are:

- Qualified, licensed and insured
- Experienced
- English speaking, most natively
- All are registered with, and have the right to work in, the Aosta Valley, where Pila is located.

Instructors will meet your pupils daily at 09.00, then they will ski with their groups until 16.00, stopping for lunch and dropping them off at the meeting point at 16.00.

They will drop skiers at the race hill as and when needed.

Training groups will generally consist of up to 8 pupils.









Race information



Pila is surrounded by mountains with long ski runs to suit all standards. It has one of the best records of snow in Italy. Children will be skiing blue, red or black runs. No offpiste skiing is offered in this trip.

Training

Will take place on practice courses for the days leading up to the event. Instructors have been hired from 0900-1600 each day. Teachers are NOT required to accompany the instructors during training unless they wish to.

Races

Are designed to encourage intermediate skiers (parallel turns) as well as more advanced racers. All races will take place over 1 slope.

Your instructor will help to oversee your competitors, but <u>teachers must</u> be present at all races to support the competitors.







Spectators

Spectators are welcome to attend the event. Flight and hotel arrangements should be made independently. If they would like any advice on the best hotels or other arrangements, they can contact Impulse Alpine directly.

Photography



Impulse Alpine will supply an event photographer who will take photos of the racers, and these will be available for parents to view and purchase after the event.

When you book onto the event you give consent for photographs to be taken of your school and the competitors. Any school with a competitor that cannot have their photograph taken must inform Impulse Alpine directly.







Ski clothing



The base layer

- Thermal underwear
- Thermal socks

The soft shell

- Fleeces
- Thin layers
- Sweaters
- Wind stoppers
- Scarves
- The mid and base layers provide essential warmth

The hard shell

- The waterproof layer (most important to have a waterproof jacket)
- Well fitted boots
- Ski pants
- Jacket
- Helmet (compulsory for all skiers)
- Goggles & sunglasses
- Sun block/cream
- Lip salve/balm







Safeguarding

Schools' responsibility

While the organiser's of the IAPS Skiing Championships ensure safeguarding measures are in place to provide a safe and enjoyable experience, it is important to note that the overall responsibility for safeguarding pupils remains with the school. Schools must continue to monitor and manage the normal risks associated with taking pupils abroad. It is essential that schools identify and assess any potential risks, ensuring they have appropriate procedures in place to keep pupils safe throughout the trip.

Skiing Instructors

All ski instructors and race coaches are licensed, insured and have the right to work in the valley. All hold current first aid certificates and, as per their teaching or coaching licenses, are DBS checked.

- Helmet + goggles
- Jacket
- Sunglasses

- Medical form, per pupil, to be completed and returned to organisers before the event so that the instructors and coaches have these when working with the children.
