





# INFORMATION & RULES

**Format:** The tournament will run as follows with four pools of 4 teams

**Timings:** All matches will be 7 minutes each way with a 1 minute half time (with rolling subs permitted).

There will be 2 minutes between matches. Matches will be centrally timed and there will be no extra time for stoppages. Any serious delay should be reported to the Tournament Referee who will adjudicate.

**Pool Stages:** 3 points awarded for a win, 1 for a draw, and 0 points for a loss. If at the end of the pool rounds two teams are level it will be decided as follows:

1. Goal difference
2. Goals scored
3. Winner of the match between tied teams
4. Barrage of 3 penalty strokes (3 players selected from the squad)
5. Sudden death penalty strokes\*\*

\*Head-to-head result between two teams is the result of the match played between the two tied teams. \*\*Sudden-death is started by the team that did not start the shoot-out and players may proceed in a different order from the initial best-of-three round

**Knockout Stages:** The top two teams from each pool will qualify for the Cup competition, whilst those teams finishing 3rd and 4th will qualify for the Plate competition

In the event of a draw at full time, the winner will be decided by:

1. A period of "Golden Goal" extra time up to a maximum of 5 minutes
2. Barrage of 3 penalty strokes\*
3. Sudden death penalty strokes\* \*

At U11 competitions, penalty strokes can be taken 5m from the goal line rather than 7m.

**Captains:** Are responsible for making the toss and ensuring their teams are on the pitch ready for the start of play.

**Umpires:** An umpiring schedule will be provided and participating schools **must** provide a **competent** umpire. (Please note that In2Hockey rules will be applied).

**Teams:** Squads can have a maximum of ten players with teams consisting of six outfield players & one fully equipped GK. Bibs will be provided in the event of a colour clash.

**Players:** Are strongly recommended to wear a GUM GUARD & SHIN PADS

Absolutely no watches or jewellery should be worn; players will be asked to leave the pitch if they are wearing jewellery during play.

Please arrived changed by 09:30 to ensure a prompt start.

## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPECTATORS

Where permitted, we are delighted to welcome spectators to attend IAPS events.

As a spectator/parent you have a responsibility to:

- Be a positive role model and lead by example. Children are involved in sport for their enjoyment and without undue spectator pressure.
- Encourage children to play by the rules and respect the officials.
- Always respect the officials and their decisions. Video evidence will not be accepted in any cases to dispute decisions.
- Always respect the coaches and their decisions. They give their time, energy and experience to coach the children.
- Refrain from any form of bad language or poor behaviour towards players, officials and fellow spectators.
- Be friendly and respectful to the opposition.
- Teach children that effort and teamwork are as important as victory so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- Turn defeat into victory by helping children work towards skill improvement and a positive sporting attitude.
