Booking onto an event:

- All bookings are made online via the IAPS website.
- Only a member of school staff with a school email address can book onto an event.

Eligibility:

- All competitors must attend an IAPS School.
- Competitors ages are taken from 1st September.
- Competitors can only participate in one age group throughout the competition.
- Only competitors who are part of the Prep School are eligible to take part. Competitors in Year 7 and Year 8 who are part of the Senior School are not eligible to take part in U12 and U13 events.
- All schools must bring first aid.

Pre-requisite of booking onto the championships

Staffing

- Schools must provide an additional member of staff/parents who will be allocated a role on the day to help with the running of the event.
- The role will be non-technical and a worked on a rota.
- Examples roles include: manning the entry desk, collecting scores for the scorers and hosting the judges in their refreshment area.
- Schools will be required to submit their volunteer's name BEFORE the competition.
- If you cannot provide an additional member of staff to support the running of the event we will be required to withdraw your entry.

Code of conduct

Schools must ask spectators to read the [IAPS parental code of conduct](#) before attending the event. Rude and poor behaviour will not be tolerated.

Honouring deadlines

- Please adhere to the deadline for entries as it is very difficult to add schools to the draw after it has been completed.
- Please ensure that you have adequate staff for the warm-up and to supervise your gymnasts if you are bringing multiple teams

- Medals for 1st place to 6th place in individual events
- Medals for 1st place to 3rd place in group events.

Ribbons

- Ribbons for 4th place – 6th place in group events.

Injury and accidents

- Great care should be taken in moving an injured competitor or ill competitor from the gym.
