## HOCKEY AT TEDDIES

Hockey is played year-round at St Edward's, with a focus on girls in the Autumn Term and boys in the Spring Term. Enthusiastic players can also opt for hockey as a Monday and Wednesday afternoon activity or take part in pre-season training across all three terms. Pupils benefit from access to the Athletic Development Centre, a physiotherapist, and the School-owned Nuffield Health Fitness and Wellbeing Centre. All players take part in sessions with our specialist athletic development coaches. The programme is led by Todd Williams, former Australian international and highly respected school and club coach. A highlight of the hockey calendar is our annual Friday Night Lights fixture at Oxford Hawks. We are passionate about hockey at Teddies, and both current and former pupils have achieved success at international, national, regional, and county levels. Millie Holme, former 1st XI girls' captain, currently plays for Wales, having represented the country at the 2022 Commonwealth Games. She now holds a place in the GB squad. Several of our pupils have recently progressed through the U16 and U18 selection process, competing in the Performance Centre Challenge Cup. Former pupil Rupert Shipperley captains Wales and represents Great Britain, having competed in the 2018 and 2022 Commonwealth Games, as well as the 2020 and 2024 Olympics. His sister, Zoe Shipperley, also a former pupil, has played as a defender for England, winning a silver medal at the 2014 Commonwealth Games.
