CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPECTATORS

Where permitted, we are delighted to welcome spectators to attend IAPS events.

As a **spectator/parent** you have a responsibility to:

1. Be a positive role model and lead by example. Children are involved in sport for their enjoyment and without undue spectator pressure.
2. Encourage children to play by the rules and respect the officials.
3. Always respect the officials and their decisions. Video evidence will not be accepted in any cases to dispute decisions.
4. Always respect the coaches and their decisions. They give their time, energy and experience to coach the children.
5. Refrain from any form of bad language or poor behaviour towards players, officials and fellow spectators.
6. Be friendly and respectful to the opposition.
7. Teach children that effort and teamwork are as important as victory so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
8. Turn defeat into victory by helping children work towards skill improvement and a positive sporting attitude.

10. Try to relax and enjoy the event!

IAPS wants all competitions to run without any negative incidents. Excitement and emotions can run high at events, not least amongst the supporters. Unpleasant and inappropriate behaviour is very rarely seen but you should be aware that **IAPS retains the right to ask you to leave the event if you fail to comply with the code of conduct.**

SAFEGUARDING



IAPS believes that the welfare and wellbeing of all children (young people under the age of 18) and adults at risk attending an IAPS event is of the highest concern. All such persons have the right to safety and protection and any suspicions, concerns or allegations of harm will be taken seriously and will be dealt with swiftly and appropriately.

IAPS expects all adults who are engaged with the delivery of sports events to fully comply with safeguarding procedures as laid out in the IAPS Safeguarding Policy and Procedures, and the KCSiE document (these are available on our website: sport.iaps.uk/safeguarding).

IAPS expects all coaches present to be DBS checked and have received relevant safeguarding training at their school/club.

EVENT INFORMATION

Parking

School minibuses should use the Queen's Drive entrance to the school (Sat Nav. Reference GU7 2BY), then turn right before the barrier and followed Duke's Drive round through the barrier to the bottom QSC Car Park (as shown on the map.) There will be Charterhouse staff at the Queen's Drive entrance to direct you and then staff at the car park to greet you and show you to the netball courts. Coaches will also enter through Queen's Drive, then go through the barrier use the BTT carpark where they can be stacked. Visitors arriving in cars should also use the Queen's Drive entrance and then turn right to use the top sports centre carpark, with overflow parking available in the BTT carpark.



Late arrivals

Please try to ensure that you arrive 30 minutes before your first match. If you miss a match due to late arrival it will result in a 3-0 loss counting against your team and the points will be awarded to your opposition. If you are not present for the beginning of a knock out match, you will forfeit the match.

Tournament schedule

Please arrive to register at the tournament HQ by the entrances to the QSC Netball Courts by 11.00am latest. There will be a short briefing to go through important onsite housekeeping for all teams at this time, please could you ensure at least one member of staff for your team attends this.

Umpires

Each team will need to bring a competent umpire and will be expected to officiate neutral matches during the group stage of the day. Charterhouse will provide umpires for the knockout stage of the cup competition, to ensure that there are neutral umpires for games deciding qualification for national finals. Teams that qualify for the plate and bowl competitions umpire their own matches during the afternoon.

EVENT INFORMATION

FIRST AID

Please bring your own first aid kits. Charterhouse will also have medical staff on site on the day, please speak to a member of Charterhouse staff at court side HQ if the medic is required.

CHANGING FACILITIES

There will be changing rooms available for competitors and these will be clearly labelled. Please note that these are not court side and will not be locked. Valuables should not be left inside. Staff and adult toilet facilities are accessible inside the Sports Centre.

REFRESHMENTS

Please advise students that they should bring their own refreshments for the day. Charterhouse will provide afternoon tea for visiting staff, parents and guardians. Players will be given snacks in the afternoon.

MERCHANDISE

IAPS are delighted to have Team Elite as our official merchandisers, to sell branded products both online and at events throughout the year. All commission made from merchandise is directly put back into running the sports programme. Merchandise can be bought online or at several IAPS sport events.

RESULTS

Results for team events will be published live using SOCS. Results for individual sports events will not be available live but will be published on our website as soon as possible after the event. Please note all results are now published in the member area of our website which is only accessible to school staff. Parents should request any information from the school.

PHOTOGRAPHY ADVICE

There is no professional photography at IAPS Sport events, however parents and spectators can take their own pictures. There is no law against taking photos at public events for personal use, including pictures of other people's children ([Ask the Police, 2018](#)). IAPS asks parents and spectators to be cautious when sharing any images on social media.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

IAPS Netball Tournaments

IAPS netball tournaments are conducted under the International Netball Federation rules and regulations, including their ruling on gender splits within tournaments. The full rules and regs can be found on the World Netball website here: <https://netball.sport/inside-wn/inf-resources/inf-rules-and-regulations>

Scoring

- 5 points for a win
- 3 points for a draw
- 1 point for scoring 50% or more of the winning teams score

Pool stage

The group order will be decided by the number of points scored by each team. In the event of a tie on points, the following will decide final placings:

1. Goal difference*
2. Total goals scored
3. Result between the two teams

*Goal difference is calculated as the number of goals scored in all league matches minus the number of goals conceded.

e.g.

Team 1 - 15 goals for – 5 goals against = +10 (this team wins)

Team 2 - 19 goal for – 10 goals against = +9

Knockout stage

In the event of a draw in the knockout stages, the winner will be decided by:

1. Five minutes of extra time.
There will be a 2-minute interval after full time before starting the extra time.
2. A period of "Golden Goal". The first team to score a goal wins the match.
The match does not stop after the 5 minutes but the umpires communicate loudly and clearly that the match has now moved into golden goal.

Qualification process

This qualification event consists of a group and knockout stage. The initial stage will be played between 4 groups 4 schools (U13) and 4 groups of 5 schools (U11). The 1st and 2nd placed team in each group will progress to the cup competition with the 3rd and 4th placed team progressing to the plate competition. 5th placed teams will be in the bowl.

U11- 2 teams Qualify from this tournament

U13- 3 teams Qualify from this tournament

Medals, badges and certificates

Medals and certificates are awarded as below:

Qualifiers 1st - 3rd place in the cup competition will receive a medal

1st place in the plate competition will receive a badge

2nd - 3rd place in the plate and 1st-3rd in the bowl will receive a certificate
