The Festival 4 All is for children who are not of an A team standard in any of the major games and will not be selected for the A team squads for any IAPS competitions.

It is ideally suited for B team and below children, those who find Sport and PE challenging, for whatever reason, but who enjoy sporting participation without the intensity of competition.

This Festival is primarily for Year 6 (U11) children but can be accessed by Year 5 (U10) children also.

### Team entry

The Festival is a team event comprising of either:

- A team of 6
- A team of 12

Teams of 12 from co-ed schools are encouraged to bring 6 boys and 6 girls.

There is a total capacity of 120 competitors.

### Cost of entry

£80 per team





## How the day will look

The children will be mixed up into teams and they will undertake different challenges related to the sports/activities that are being coached.

The following sports will be covered:

- Hockey
- Cricket
- Athletics or Tennis
- Generic Fitness and Fundamental Movement

Teams will spend 90 minutes on each sport/activity and in that 90 minutes the children will be engaged in coaching practices and skills challenges.

There will be no ranking or direct competition between schools. Every child will receive a participation certificate outlining what they have learned and achieved during the day.

Medals will be awarded during each rotation for children who have shown great enthusiasm, sportsmanship, helpfulness, friendship towards others, overcoming a challenge and for trying their best.
