### Entering the competition

#### Booking onto an event:

- All bookings are made online via the IAPS website.
- Only a member of school staff with a school email address can book onto an event.
- If the event is fully booked, please join the waiting list. Should space become available, we will contact you to offer you the space. There is no guarantee we can find schools space to attend.

#### Eligibility:

- All competitors must attend an IAPS School.
- Competitors ages are taken from 1st September.
- Only competitors who are part of the Prep School are eligible to take part. Competitors in Year 7 and Year 8 who are part of the Senior School are not eligible to take part in U12 and U13 events.
- All schools must bring first aid and additional first aid might be provided.
- Each school may enter as many pupils as they like.

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### Event information

#### Venue

- The event takes place at Monkton Prep School, Combe Down, Bath. Please use BA2 5DL as the postcode for satnavs.

#### Equipment you may need

- Swim – Tri suit/swimming costume/trunks, goggles, swimming hat
- Bike – Bike, helmet, cycling shoes (if desired), water bottle (optional), race belt (preferable), t-shirt (if not using a tri-suit)
- Run – Running shoes
- Other useful items to have in transition – towel, talc, elastic laces in your shoes

#### THE RACE

##### Swim distances

| Year Group | Swim distance           | Swim laps/lengths              |
|------------|-------------------------|--------------------------------|
| Year 5     | 150m (50m in each lane) | 6 (enter lane 2; exit lane 4)  |
| Year 6     | 200m (50m in each lane) | 8 (enter lane 1; exit lane 4)  |
| Year 7     | 200m (50m in each lane) | 8 (enter lane 1; exit lane 4)  |
| Year 8     | 300m (75m in each lane) | 12 (enter lane 1; exit lane 4) |

##### Bike distances

| Year group | Cycle distance | Cycle laps |
|------------|----------------|------------|
| Year 5     | 2000m          | 2          |
| Year 6     | 4000m          | 4          |
| Year 7     | 4000m          | 4          |
| Year 8     | 6000m          | 6          |

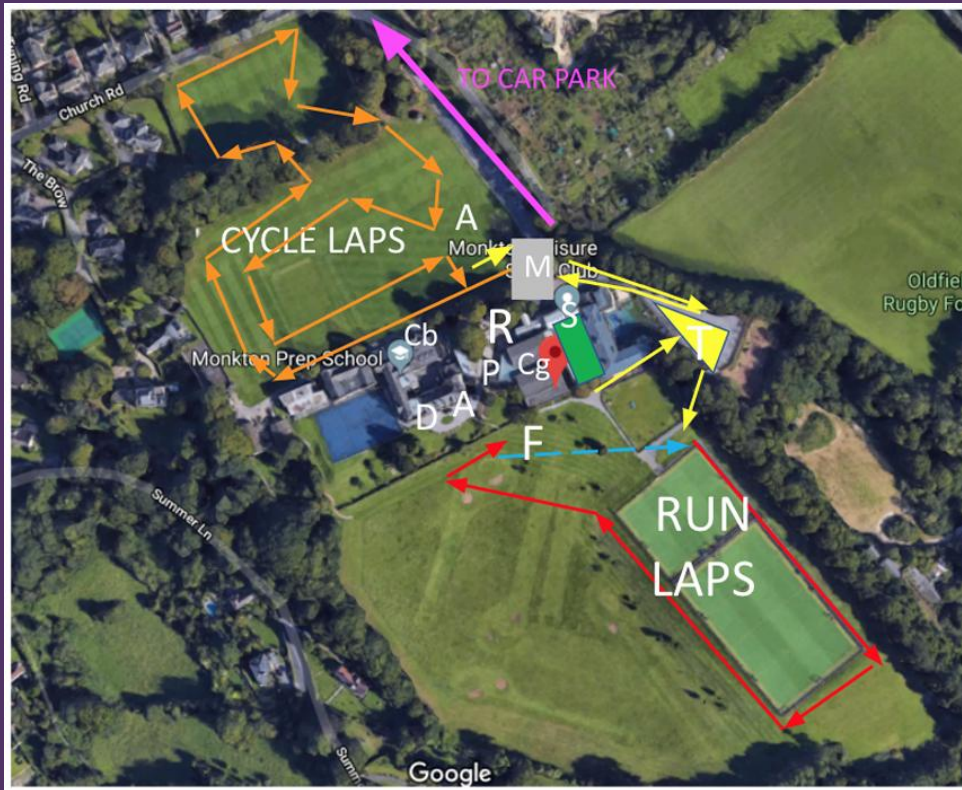
##### Run distances

| Year group | Run distance | Run laps |
|------------|--------------|----------|
| Year 5     | 1200m        | 2        |
| Year 6     | 1800m        | 3        |
| Year 7     | 1800m        | 3        |
| Year 8     | 2400m        | 4        |



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### Race packs

- On the day, all competitors will receive a race pack at registration
- This will include a timing chip and race numbers
