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Host a sports event

We are very fortunate to have a lot of generous schools which like to host our events, but we are always keen to collaborate with new schools.

<u>A brief overview of hosting an IAPS sport event:</u>

IAPS Sport will:

- Offer schools one free place at their event.
- Undertake all administration and bookings.
- Promote the event to member schools.
- Contribute towards agreed expenses.
- Arrange for branded medals to be delivered to your event.
- Be the first point of call for support and advice.

Host school will:

- Ensure it has appropriate insurance in place.
- Submit their predicted event expenses to IAPS prior to the event, to be agreed with IAPS.
- Create an event programme.
- Run the event.
- Record results from the event.
- Submit expenses to be paid by IAPS.
