### **Ashford School**

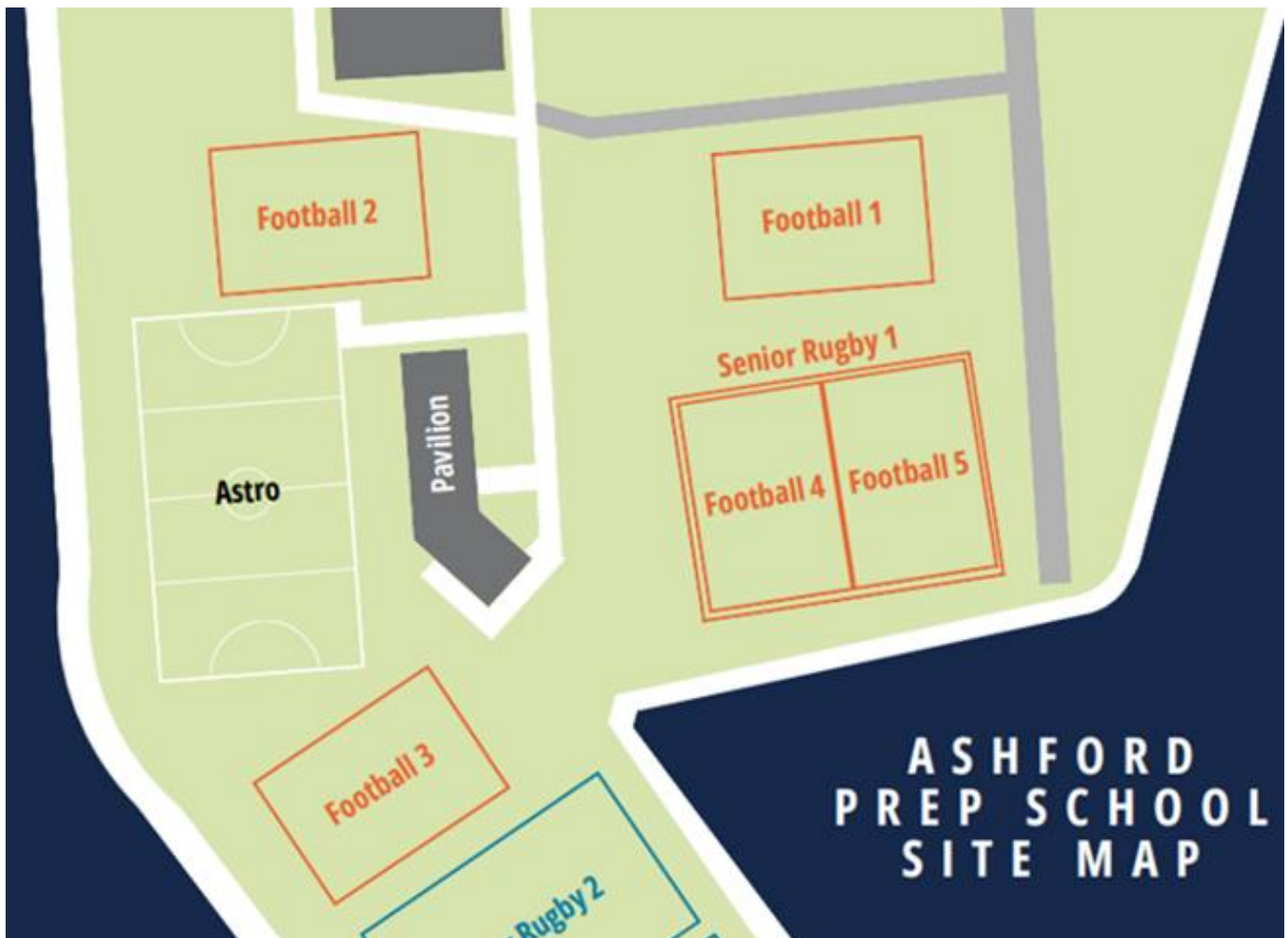
Here at Ashford School our ethos is Sport for All, which means that every child gets the chance to represent the school competitively.

## Additional Information

### **Parking**

Tea, coffee, water, squash, and snacks will be available in the pavilion throughout the day for staff and spectators. Lunch will be provided for umpires and teachers from 12.30pm. Please ensure your students provide their own lunch, ensuring **no nuts or fizzy drinks**.

There will be a water filling station in the pavilion.

### **Extra Provisions**

Our school fields have little shelter from weather. We will be providing a few gazebos to shelter under. Please feel free to bring your own in addition.

### **Rules:**

- Teams must be made up of no more than 10 players (7-side matches).
- The top two teams from every group will qualify for the cup quarter finals, whilst the third and fourth placed teams will enter the plate quarter finals.
- The results will be recorded as follows (3 for a win, 1 for a draw). Goals difference will also be recorded. If points are level, then goal difference will come into play.
- Normal 7-side rules + heading permitted. (No GK drop kicks)
- Nearest defender is allowed no closer than 3m.
- All Games are **12 minutes** straight through. 15 minutes have been allocated per match to allow for transition time between games.
- If knockout stage matches are tied then games will go straight to penalties, with each team getting 3 penalties, if still a draw, sudden penalties will commence.
- Neutral referees will be provided by Ashford Prep School
- Subs will be able to roll on/roll off during breaks in the game.

Games will be centrally timed, please ensure you transition between games promptly.
