Age groups

Level of golfer

Competitors must be competent golfers and not total beginners.

The event is not a handicapped, but we ask you to provide children's handicaps (if they have one) on the booking form to make the scheduling of tee times easier.

Practice round

Schools must provide one marker per team, this must be a member of school staff and not a parent/quardian.
