- Minibuses should park at the Stamford Junior School Nursery Car Park (PE9 2WB). **Please let us know if you require a parking spot reserving for your minibus.**

Coaches should drop off and collect from the layby outside Stamford 6th Form (PE9 2LL) and walk down Kettering Road to the courts as there is no coach drop off at courts.

- **Court allocation:** We will have 5 playable courts and a warmup court (which will not be used for match play due to tree roots incursion) – the order of play is below.
- **Game details:** U11 netball competitions

Rules summary - All IAPS competitions are run in line with national governing body (NGB) rules and regulations (England Netball).

Bee Netball is the format of the game for all children U11.

The U11 competition will play Stage 3 (Stinger) of Bee Netball. [England Netball | Stinger – Rule Adaptations](#)

This incorporates a minimum squad size of 7 players (can take a squad of up to 9) with 5 on the court at any one time.

- **Umpiring:** We will have a number of umpires onsite who will assist in rotation, but we cannot cover all the courts so ***PLEASE be prepared to chip in!***
- **Medical:** Assistance will be available, but please bring your medibags.
- **Facilities:** Toilets are available in the Wothorpe Sports Centre, over the Kettering road (there is a pelican crossing to assist crossing) and there will be payable refreshments available there for spectators and visitors. We will provide tea, coffee, snacks for visiting staff.
- The festival will be run in the same positive, relaxed spirit as always!

ORDER OF PLAY

POOL MATCHES

- This qualifier consists of **2 pools of 6 teams**.
- Matches will be **6 minutes each way**.
- Straight swap over at half time and 3 minutes between games.
- The 1st and 2nd placed team in each pool will progress to the cup competition.
- The 3rd and 4th placed team in each pool will progress to the plate competition.
- The 5th and 6th teams in each pool will progress to the bowl competition.



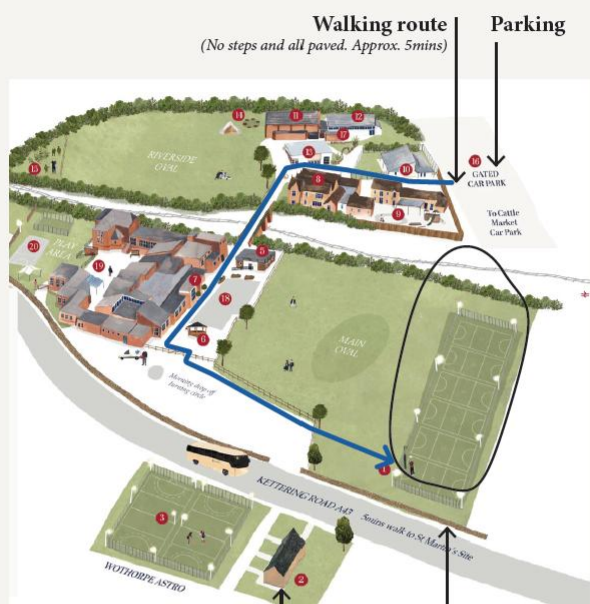
