

Session Plan KS1 (15-30 minutes)

Can you spot online bullying?



Timing	Activity	Slide(s)
3 minutes	Starter: Can the children answer the questions and do they know or recognise any of the apps/games?	2
2 minutes	Introduction: Introduce the VoteTopic and learning journey.	2-4
2-4 minutes	Why are we talking about this? Introduce Anti-Bullying Week, use the video to explain what the theme is this year. Discuss how the children feel about this.	5
4-8 minutes	What should you do? In pairs ask the children to look at the next 4 slides and talk about what the person should do. Afterwards ask some of the children to explain their answers.	7-11
3-6 minutes	What should you do continued? As a class, discuss the case studies and what the children should do if they were in that position. Clarify that all children should tell an adult. Also clarify the meaning of bullying. Introduce online bullying, and ask pupils what would they do if this happened. Use the activity on slide 14 to create a class list on how to stay safe online.	12-14
3-5 minutes	Give the gift of kindness: On their own, ask the children to write something nice about someone in their class and give it to the teacher. Share some of the comments and discuss the importance of being kind to each other.	16
2-3 minutes	Yes/No summary: Pupils consider the 2 different sides before voting.	17-18
