

## Session Plan (15 mins)

### Do anonymous apps make bullying worse?



Timing	Activity	Slide(s)
N/A	<b>Feedback:</b> Allow students some time to read the feedback on the topic we did on Banksy's art.	2
2 minutes	<b>Why are we talking about this?</b> Use the slide to discuss with students why we are discussing this topic this week. If you have some time, watch the video about this year's theme for Anti-Bullying Week.	4
4 minutes	<b>What are anonymous apps for?</b> Look at the case study of YikYak and watch the video to discover what the founders were hoping to achieve by making it anonymous.	5
4 minutes	<b>Are anonymous apps dangerous?</b> Read through the story of YikYak and the examples of hateful comments that users were posting then discuss the question on anonymity in small groups. Feedback to the class.	6
4 minutes	<b>Could anonymous apps tackle bullying?</b> Pick one of the two anonymous apps and watch the video to learn more about it. Do students think this could work in your school to tackle bullying?	7
N/A	<b>Call to Action:</b> Use the ideas below and on the slide to encourage your students to really get involved and make a difference on this years anti-bullying campaign.	8
1 minute	<b>Yes/No summary:</b> Encourage students to reflect on this topic before they vote.	9
