

## 866 MFL: Language Learning Symposium

**Date: Tuesday 13 March 2018**

**Venue: Broadway House, Tothill Street, London SW1H 9NQ**

This course focuses on the importance of Independent Language Learning Strategies. Ernesto Macaro is a widely published and world-renowned researcher and speaker in this field and we are delighted that he will be leading the whole day. In order for delegates to gain the most from the course and take home practical ideas, the day has been split into two sections. The morning will consist of Ernesto's introduction, outlining the basics of Language Learning Strategy instruction. Delegates will then work together in different groups to produce a short language lesson plan using the principles from the talk. Ernesto will observe the ideas and lesson plans. The afternoon session will consist of feedback given on the lesson observed and the ideas discussed. Ernesto will complete his presentation by highlighting the most recent research in this field and how it impacts on learners.

**Objectives:** Delegates will have the opportunity to participate in workshops and network with their peers, and take away practical ideas on independent language learning strategies.

**Course Director:** James Lanzon, Feltonfleet Prep School and IAPS MFL Subject Adviser

**Speaker:** Dr Ernesto Macaro is a Professor of Applied Linguistics at the University of Oxford. Before becoming a teacher trainer and researcher he was a language teacher in secondary schools in the UK for 16 years. His current research focuses on second language learning strategies and on the interaction between teachers and learners in classrooms.
