

905: Safeguarding for Prep Schools (*a joint course with BSA*)

Date: Monday 28 January 2019

Venue: Caldicott Prep School, Crown Lane, Franham Royal Buckinghamshire SL2 3SL

Cost: Online £229 (non IAPS and non BSA members – additional £100)

The course will explore a range of current issues, including those which relate to “keeping children safe” and those which relate to promoting well-being. The course will include a boarding perspective for those schools which have full, weekly or flexi boarding, but the content will be relevant to all schools. Topics will include supporting vulnerable children, medical matters, well-being, bullying; online safety, handling disclosures and working together with other agencies. Guidance will also be given on how to deal with allegations of non-recent abuse. There will also be ample opportunity to network with colleagues fulfilling similar positions in other prep schools.

Audience: Prep Heads, Deputy Heads, Designated Safeguarding Leads and Safeguarding Governors

Objectives: This course aims to raise awareness of updates to relevant legislation and statutory guidance; increase understanding of current safeguarding issues and challenges in prep schools; ensure the best possible outcomes for those transitioning to senior school; promote positive mental health and well-being, and develop strategies for responding appropriately and empathetically to allegations of non-recent abuse



How to find us

From The South (M4)

Distance from M4 junction - about 3.8 miles.

- Take junction 6 on the M4
- Go north (Slough) on the A355.
- Go straight on at the next, large, roundabout, straight across at the A4 traffic lights, then follow the road through several sets of lights.
- Across the next big roundabout.
- Turn left at the next (double) roundabout.
- Ignore the first right, follow the road round, and take the second right (Crown Lane) just before the 40mph sign.
- Caldicott is almost a mile down Crown Lane, at the top of the hill, just before you get to the road junction.

From The North (M40)

Distance from the M40 junction - about 3.4 miles.

- Take Junction 2 on the M40
- South on the A355 (Slough). Keep straight on for about 2½ miles. Pass Templewood Lane on the left, and then turn right. This is Beeches Road
- Go to the T-Junction at the end of Beeches Road and turn left. Follow the road round, veering sharply right, and then just before the road curves right again, go straight on. Caldicott is IMMEDIATELY on the left after the junction (Crown Lane).

Parking

Please park at the front of the school, either in spaces on hard standing (tennis course) area of, if dry enough, on the grassed car park. These car parks will likely offer 20 and 60 slots respectively. Security/marshalling will be provided. Please report to main reception.
