

918: Learning Beyond the Classroom

In the morning, delegates will focus on curriculum-based teaching and learning using simple methods and low/no cost resources. In the afternoon, we will shift our attention to teaching for character around themes such as team skills, co-operation, collaboration, resilience trust etc. and how to embed these into an experiential outdoor approach and culture at your school. The day will provide lots of thoughts, insights, practical tips and tools for incorporating outdoor learning at your school. We will also help you create a robust and clear action plan to return to your school with to influence colleagues and decision makers.

How to find us

Please note: Many SatNav devices do not bring you to the correct place when attempting to reach the postcode, therefore please follow the directions below for when you are nearing the school.

From the south... via the M1, exit at junction 17 on to the M45. At the end of the M45 roundabout take 2nd exit, signed Dunchurch.

From the west... via the A45, do not join the M45 but follow signs to Dunchurch. In Dunchurch at traffic lights turn left. Proceed for 3/4 mile. The School entrance is on the right.

From the north... via the M1 exit at junction 18. You cannot leave the M1 at junction 17 from the north. Follow the signs for Rugby (A428) and then Banbury on the B4429/A426.

From the east... via the A14, then M6, exit at junction 1 to Rugby. Follow signs to Dunchurch through Rugby. Bilton Grange is 1/4 mile on the left along the A426 from the Sainsbury's roundabout.

By rail... Rugby Station is on a direct line from London, Euston (approx. 1 hour) and Birmingham (15 minutes).

By air... Birmingham Airport is approx 25 minutes drive from the School.

On arrival: Delegates may park anywhere in the car parks and report initially to the main reception (all clearly signed).
