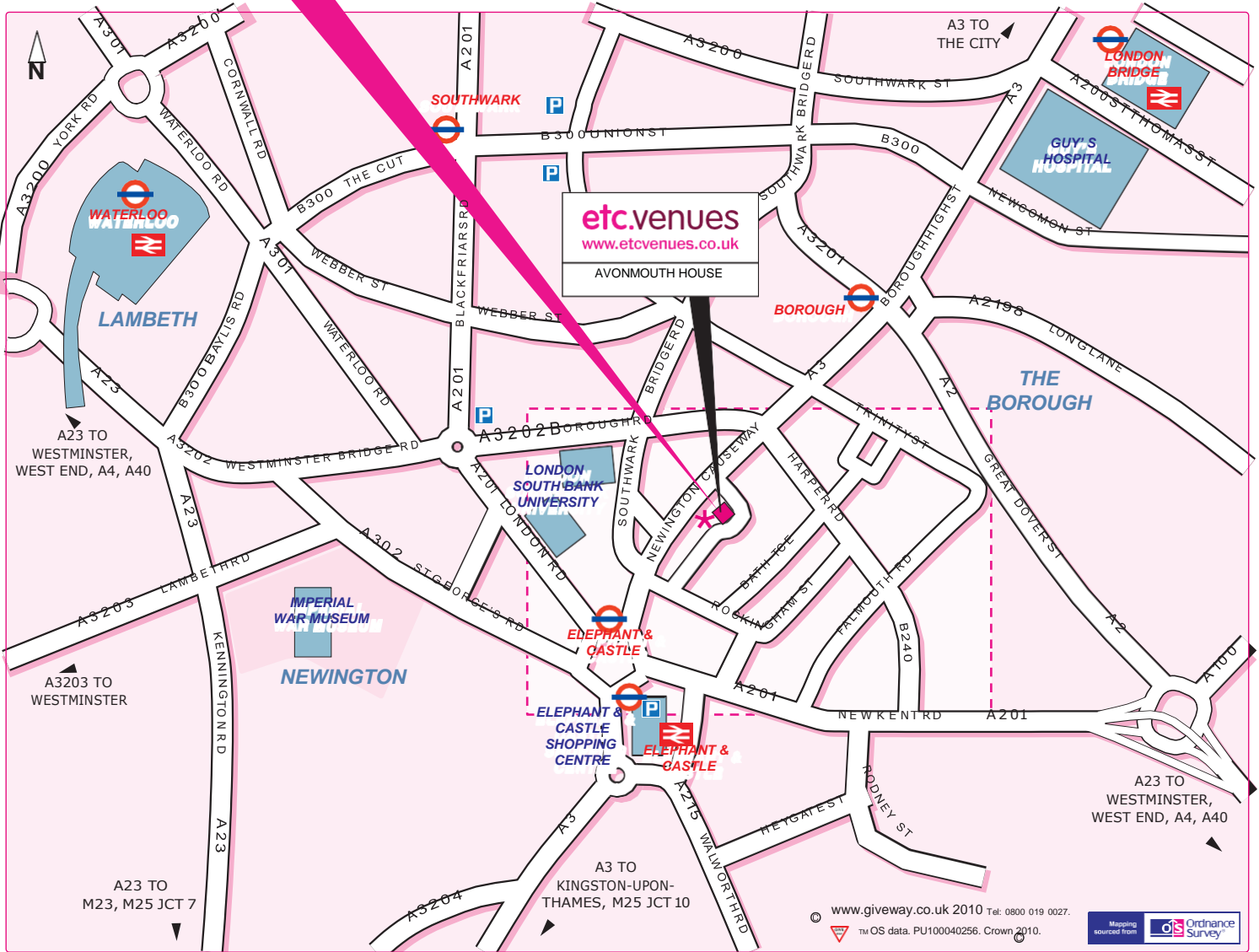
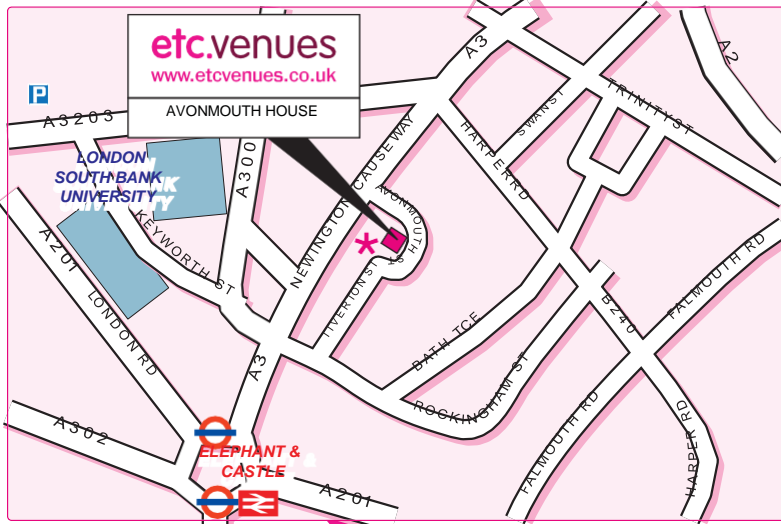

Public Transport

★ Avonmouth House is located just off Newington Causeway in Avonmouth Street. 5 minutes from Elephant and Castle Underground and Mainline stations, and 5 minutes from Borough underground on the Northern Line.

By Underground
 Elephant and Castle Underground - Exit the tube station and head north up Newington Causeway towards London Bridge. You will pass Salvation Army on your right, continue under the railway bridge and take the next road on the right named Avonmouth Street. Avonmouth House is clearly signposted and located on the right.
 Borough Tube – Turn right out of the tube station and continue down Borough highstreet. At the crossroads continue across the road and then at the next cross roads cross straight over bringing you on to Newington Causeway. Avonmouth Street is directly opposite the pedestrian cross and Avonmouth House is signposted once in to Avonmouth Street

By Rail
 Follow signs for Elephant and Castle Shopping centre. Walk into the shopping centre and turn right, take the stairs to the lower level and walk out through the exit doors. Take the underpass straight through and up on to Newington Causeway. Walk past the Salvation Army building, under the railway bridge and Avonmouth Street is the next road on the right.

By Bus
 There are regular buses from all mainline stations (except Paddington) to Elephant & Castle although the underground is usually faster. Visit www.tfl.gov.uk for more details on routes and buses

Parking
 There is limited meter parking on Avonmouth Street and the surrounding roads. Please note: Avonmouth House has limited parking slots which must be reserved beforehand. The slots are allocated on a first come, first served basis and are subject to availability. Please remember the venue sits within the congestion charge zone – for further information visit www.cclondon.com
