By Road

From the A64 follow the signs to the city centre. The hotel is adjacent to York Railway Station.

There is a car park - for non-residents parking is charged at £3 per hour up to 4 hours or £15 for 24 hours.

Special rate for course delegates - £10 for the day.

Alternative car parking can be found at the Railway Station and National Rail Museum.

By Rail

The Principal York is next door to York Station which serves many destinations around the country, including Newcastle, Edinburgh, Manchester and London King's Cross.

The hotel is located next to York railway station. There is an entrance to the hotel direct from Platform 2. From the front of York railway station, turn left along Station Road, and the hotel main entrance and car park are on your left.

From the **station entrance**: walk up the steps, through the double doors and turn left. The Oak Room is straight ahead at the end of the corridor.

From the **hotel main entrance and car park**: turn right and the Oak Room is straight ahead at the end of the corridor.

By Air

[Leeds Bradford International Airport](#) is 30 miles, or 45 minutes via taxi, from The Principal York. A typical fare is £50-60. Leeds Bradford Airport is about an hour's flight from [London Heathrow Airport](#).
