

950 Music: conducting for choirs and orchestras – essential knowledge and the difference between the two

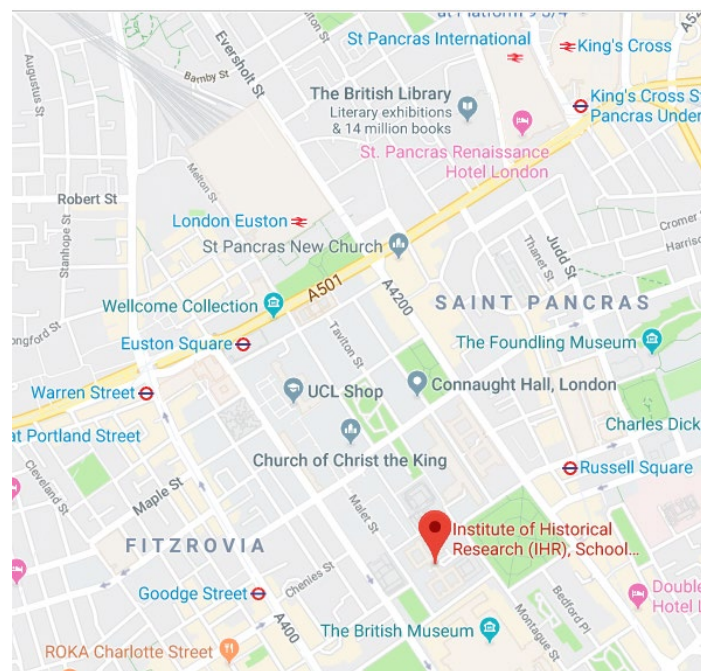
