

## Previous itrust beneficiaries

itrust aims to support the education of children and their teachers. Many people have benefited from itrust funding and in a number of different ways, including those listed below.

### Benevolent fund

Examples of benevolent grants awarded :

- A senior school teacher, to help address rent arrears incurred as a result of an incident in school which made it difficult to work.
- A family, where both parents were teachers, whose eldest daughter is severely disabled. Funding allowed the younger daughter to attend a local boarding school and provide respite from a difficult home situation
- A former IAPS head who had retired without a pension and was experiencing some financial difficulties. His family made the charity aware of his situation as he was too proud to ask for help.

### Bursary scheme

Examples of bursaries awarded :

- A boy whose mother is unemployed due to severe health issues as a result of domestic abuse; the family needed to be on the move to safe houses and different schools. He is now settled in one school, happy in weekly boarding and making good progress.
- A father is very ill and unable to work. His son needs a small focused environment with excellent pastoral care with weekly boarding.
