### Event information

#### Age groups

- This competition is for both individual and/or team entries.
- A team is made up of 3 players per age group.
- Schools can enter only 1 team per age group.

#### Level of golfer

Competitors must be competent golfers and not total beginners.

The event is not a handicapped, but we ask you to provide children's handicaps (if they have one) on the booking form to make the scheduling of tee times easier.

#### Practice round

Competitors can play a practice round the day before the competition or anytime in the lead up to the competition.

The competition will take place on the Avening Course

A modified stableford scoring system will be used.

#### Markers

Schools must provide one marker per team, this must be a member of school staff and not a parent/guardian.
