Booking onto an event

- All bookings are made online via the [IAPS website](#).
- Only a member of school staff with a school email address can book onto an event.
- If the event is fully booked, please join the waiting list. Should a space become available, we will contact you to offer you the space. There is no guarantee we can find schools a space.

Entry eligibility

- All competitors must attend an IAPS School.
- Competitors ages is taken from 1st September.
- Competitors can only participate in one age group throughout the competition.
- Unless otherwise specified, schools can only enter one team per tournament/championships.
- Only competitors who are part of the Prep School are eligible to take part. Competitors in Year 7 and Year 8 who are part of the Senior School are not eligible to take part in U13 events.
- All schools must bring first aid.

Entries

- Schools may enter 4 competitors per age group.

Format

- This tournament is a singles competition for girls and boys.
- Competitors will play a round robin format followed by a knockout cup and plate competition.

Equipment

- Competitors should be dressed appropriately.
- No white shirts are to be worn.
- Tracksuits are not suitable for actual play.
